

What is my return on investment?

Return on investment (ROI) is used when describing a performance measure or value associated with a specific activity. For example, pursuing the UofL Education Specialist (Ed.S) is an investment in one's career and will lead to a real monetary difference.

The chart below provides you with the ROI and is based upon the *Average Kentucky School District 19-20 Pay Scales*. Note: Teacher Salary for 20-21 SY -- \$49,451 Rank II, Step 5.

Position <i>Post Ed.S</i>	Ed.S Degree Cost Includes textbooks	Salary <i>Pre-Ed.S</i>	Salary <i>Post Ed.S</i>	ROI
Remain a Teacher	\$15,000	\$49,451	\$56,151 Rank 1 Step 7	14% or 2 ¼ years
Become a High School Assistant Principal	\$15,000	\$49,451	\$71,890 Rank 1 Step 7	45% or ¾ year
Become an Elementary School Principal	\$15,000	\$49,451	\$86,400 Rank 1 Step 7	75% or 4 months
