

## University of Louisville High School Dual Credit Program

### English and Mathematics Policies and Requirements

#### Teacher Eligibility Requirements:

- Submit transcripts and curriculum vita to the UofL English or Math Department
- Master's degree or at least 18 graduate credit hours in content area
- **English only:** Prior completion or concurrent enrollment in English 602
- Participation in a one-day orientation session
- Site visits, observations, and review of student assessments by dual credit coordinator

Each department may be able to provide an instructor for the course if no faculty member on staff meets the qualifications.

#### Student eligibility requirements:

- GPA 3.0
- Gain nomination of high school teacher in the content area
- Obtain approval of the high school principal
- **English:**
  - Demonstrate writing competence
  - Meet minimum UofL entrance requirements of SAT (480), ACT (20) or PSAT (50)
- **Math:**
  - Successful completion of high school Algebra 1&2, Geometry
  - Precalculus (Math 190): Math subscore of 23 ACT, 550 SAT, or 55 PSAT
  - College Algebra (Math 111): Math subscore of 20 ACT, 480 SAT, or 50 PSAT

#### Other:

- **Math and English Textbooks:** Dual credit courses need not use the same textbook as on-campus sections, but each textbook must be approved by the department before the course is offered.
- **Scheduling:** Schools on the trimester schedule may offer a dual credit course during two trimesters, but the course must run during consecutive trimesters of the same school year.
- **Changes:** The departments reserve the right to make changes to these policies as deemed necessary by the department chair and/or the dual credit coordinator.
