

International Baccalaureate Credit

UofL awards credit on the basis of scores on the International Baccalaureate Examinations. **Scores must be submitted to the Office of Admissions as soon as they are available.** Upon receipt of test scores the appropriate credit hours will be entered on the student's record. If new freshmen test scores are received after the time of summer orientation/registration, then students will need to work with their academic adviser to ensure duplicate courses are not taken.
