

# TRANSFER DEGREE PATHWAY GUIDE

Associate in Science to Bachelor of Science in Nursing

## Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associates in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing at the University of Louisville.

#### Admission Requirements

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing is a two-tier program composed of lower and upper division curriculum. Applicants to UL must apply and be admitted into the lower division of the degree program prior to applying to the upper division of the degree program. Transfers who have earned 24+ hours of undergraduate college course work, must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.8 (on a 4.0 scale) to be admitted to lower division.

Please note: Admission to the lower division does not guarantee admission to the upper division. Admission to upper division is competitive and based on student program GPA. A minimum cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.8 and a minimum program GPA of 3.0 is required to apply to upper division.

## **Degree Requirements**

The baccalaureate degree in science is the undergraduate degree offered by the university. It is awarded to students who have completed both university-wide requirements and the requirements of the selected degree program. The following university-wide requirements apply to all baccalaureate degrees, please consult with your academic unit for specific degree completion requirements. The student must complete all Cardinal Core requirements, complete all required courses and program requirements listed in this form, have a cumulative GPA of at least a 2.00 (2.5 required to graduate with BSN), or higher, complete 120 hours applicable to this program, and complete at least 60 hours at an accredited 4-year institution.
