PORT 100-level or 200-level Intensive Portuguese (3 U of L credits)

New Application Deadline: Monday, February 19, 2007.

This set of instructions and information complements that found at the end of the Application itself (see end of Application).

- Applicants should have 24 credit hours (1 year's worth of study) earned toward a degree.
- Everything else being equal, undergraduate students are given preference.
- Reasonable progress toward degree expected.
- Applicants must be available to travel during the entire period of the course.
- Previous travel experience and/or familiarity with the Portuguese language are not required.
- Student expenses and scholarships

Total student cost: \$1,900

Note: Enrollment in ANTH 332 \$1566; Meals \$500; Books, local travel and incidentals: \$300 = \$2366. PSP scholarship reduces this total to \$1900.

Note: students responsible for most of own meals, so meal total can vary significantly by student.

Deposit required: \$300. This is to be submitted immediately upon acceptance. We ask for check or money order to be made out to "University of Louisville." (Non-refundable. See information at end of application form.)

Portuguese Studies Program automatically grants scholarships to accepted students which cover remaining costs: international travel, lodging, and partial course expenses.

Note: Anthropology majors may also apply for Departmental International Travel Awards.

The following will be requested of you upon notification of acceptance. They are submitted, with your Student Release and Assumption of Risk Form and the Overseas Emergency Information Sheet, to Paula Huffman.

- A copy of the photo page of your passport. If you do not yet possess a passport, apply for one ASAP (at the Main Post Office, 1420 Gardiner Lane, Phone #454-1650). Forms can be found at the following website: http://travel.state.gov/passport/passport_1738.html

The fee is \$97.00 for passports and \$67.00 for renewals. Passports are good for 10 years. Standard delivery time is 6 weeks.

- A copy of your International Student ID card
(The card costs \$22 and is obtained on campus from the International Center. Purchase must be made by money order. The card provides a certain level of insurance.)
