- The Hite Scholarship

* *Must be graduate of a Kentucky high school to be considered for the Hendershot and Nay Scholarship.*

Up to five finalists who do not receive the Kenady Lynne Hendershot or Mary Spencer Nay scholarship will receive Hite Scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$7,500.

* **NOTE:** *All scholarship and award amounts may vary depending on tuition rates.*

Review and Selection Process

A minimum 3.0 grade point average is required for applicants to be considered. The Department of Fine Arts Scholarship Committee will review each application and assess the applicant's academic standing, artistic/academic potential, personal goals, and determination to succeed in achieving his/her objectives. Applicants chosen as finalists will then be interviewed by the faculty, preferably on the University of Louisville campus. From this select number of finalists, the Kenady Lynne Hendershot Scholar and Mary Spencer Nay Scholar will be chosen. Finalists not chosen for the Hendershot or Nay awards will be considered for Hite Scholarships and should not apply separately for the Hite Scholarship.

Application Checklist

Each applicant must submit the following directly to the Hite Art Institute at the address below.

- ___ An Application for Admission for Major in Fine Arts (if not yet submitted)
- ___ The department's Scholarship Application Form for Incoming Freshman completed application form (page 2 of this document).
- ___ An official transcript of all high school work completed.
- ___ Three letters of recommendation from teachers or other school personnel. If you have studied art in high school, one of these letters should come from your art teacher.
- ___ A typed essay (500-600 words) describing your educational and career objectives in the arts.
- ___ Supplemental materials:
Studio Art, Communication Art & Design (Graphic Design) or Interior Architecture applicants must submit a portfolio of approximately 10 pieces of completed work. The portfolio may be in the form of slides, a cd, or original work.
Art History applicants must submit a typed essay oriented toward art appreciation or critique, of at least 700 to 1,000 words in length. The essay should reflect not only the student's writing ability but also the ability to respond visually and analytically to one or more works of art. This is in addition to the above essay describing your educational and career objectives in the arts.
- ___ If you are completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) the original must be filed with the University of Louisville Financial Aid Office by March 15.
