Priority1 a: improve student success rate:

Base

- Achieve a second-to-third year retention rate of 70% (Anthropology rarely has incoming freshmen as majors)
- Improve QMS survey - overall impression of unit by continuing students - mean response to 4.4 (from 4.18)
- Improve QMS survey - overall impression of unit by graduating students - mean response to 3.80 (from 3.53)

Intermediate

- Achieve a second-to third year retention rate of 73%
- Improve QMS survey - overall impression of unit by continuing students - mean response to 4.5
- Improve QMS survey - overall impression of unit by graduating students - mean response to 4.0

High

- achieve a second-to-third year retention rate of 75%
- Improve QMS survey - overall impression of unit by continuing students - mean response to 4.6
- Improve QMS survey - overall impression of unit by graduating students - mean response to 4.2

Priority 1b: Increase faculty productivity

Base

- Increase the total number of research grants and contract proposals submitted to 4
- Increase the total number of research grants and contracts proposals awarded to 2
- Increase the total publications in refereed journals to 5
- Increase the total number of books published to 1
- Increase the total number of refereed presentations and/or papers sponsored by national or international organizations to 6

### Intermediate

- Increase the total number of research grants and contract proposals submitted to 5
- Increase the total number of research grants and contracts proposals awarded to 3
- Increase the total publications in refereed journals to 6
- Increase the total number of books published to 2
