ATTESTATION & DISCLOSURE FORM IN IRIS

Everyone is required to complete an Attestation and Disclosure Form (ADF) on an annual basis according to UofL policy. FACILITIES & ADMINISTRATIVE (F&A) RATES

The new F&A indirect cost rates for organized research on campus are: July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016: 53% July 1, 2016-June 30, 2018: 54%

STATE LAW COMPLIANCE - SENSITIVE DATA

Any paperwork or email containing names and ID numbers is considered to be sensitive data. Paperwork containing sensitive data must be delivered in sealed envelopes. To secure a campus mail envelope, sign your name on the flap and tape over your signature. If you are carrying the paperwork to the copier or to another person, place it in a file folder. All sensitive data is to be kept locked up when you are away from your office (even if it is just for lunch).

Emails containing names and ID numbers should always be sent through Microsoft Exchange or CardMail so they are automatically encrypted. Email sent from a personal email account is not encrypted even if it says "on behalf of" faculty's name "@louisville.edu." Do not use personal email accounts when sending proposals or making access requests for students.
