

WILMA SHAW ROSEMAN SCHOLARSHIP

THE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES ANNOUNCES THE 2009-2010 ROSEMAN SCHOLARSHIPS

APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 23, 2009

The Wilma Shaw Roseman Scholarships assist full-time undergraduate students in the College of Arts and Sciences who are strongly motivated to complete their degrees and who have substantial financial need. The minimum Roseman Award is \$3,000.

To be eligible for a Roseman Scholarship, students must be full-time undergraduate students matriculated in the College of Arts and Sciences and must have demonstrated financial need as certified by the University of Louisville Office of Financial Aid. A financial aid application for academic year 2009-2010 must be on file with the Office of Financial Aid by March 15. *Former Roseman Scholarship recipients are eligible to reapply.*

Applicants for a Roseman Scholarship should submit the following to Dr. Roselle Taylor, Office of the Dean, College of Arts and Sciences, University of Louisville, Louisville, KY 40292

1. A completed application form (available in the Arts & Sciences Advising Center, the Arts & Sciences Dean's Office, and the Office of Financial Aid).
2. A 2-3 page letter discussing your educational and career goals and the way in which a Roseman Scholarship would assist you in pursuit of your degree.
3. Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be from a U of L faculty member. *(Letters of recommendation should be sent directly to Dr. Taylor at the address above.)*
4. A copy of your unofficial transcript

Electronic applications are not accepted. No incomplete applications will be considered.

A faculty committee will review applications and interview finalists for the awards.

Awards will be announced in early May.
