Scholarship recipients will be competitively selected based on academic record, recommendations, and statement concerning their commitment to a career of public service.

1. A completed application form, available at <http://louisville.edu/artsandsciences/students/scholarships>
2. Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be from a University of Louisville faculty member. Letters should be submitted to the above-indicated e-mail address.
3. A personal statement (maximum length 4 pages) introducing yourself to the selection committee and commenting on:
 - your present and past service activities;
 - the career you plan to pursue and your reasons for choosing this career;
 - the contribution to society that you hope to make through this career.
4. A copy of your unofficial transcript

No incomplete applications will be considered.

Awards will be announced in early May.
