ACCESS AUTHORIZATION

1. I, Tony Young, am a member of Louisville Industrial Park LLC, and as such I have the authority to sign this authorization.

2. I grant authorization to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"), its officers, employees, contractors and other authorized representatives to enter the property located at 1391 Dixie Highway, Louisville, KY 40210 (the "Site"). The Site is currently owned by Louisville Industrial Park LLC. This authorization allows EPA, its officers, employees, contractors and other authorized representatives to have access to the Site to conduct a time-critical removal action. EPA's activities at the Site will include, but not be limited to, the following:

a. the taking of such soil, water, and air samples as may be determined to be necessary;

b. the sampling of any solids or liquids stored or disposed of onsite;

c. other actions related to the investigation of surface or subsurface contamination;

d. restrict access to the Site by erecting new fencing and repairing damaged areas of the fence that surrounds the Site, installing new locks, installing security lighting and motion detectors, posting signage, and/or arranging for an onsite security service to deter intruders and trespassers;

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e. the taking of a response action including removal of contaminated soil and debris

f. transport and dispose of all wastes to a facility approved by the EPA;

g. perform confirmation soil sampling and treat or dispose of soil;

h. transport equipment onto and about the Site as necessary to accomplish the above activities;

and

i. inspect and copy all documents relating to the generation, treatment, storage, disposal, or source of hazardous substances at the Site.

3. The consent for access and use granted herein will commence on August 8, 2011 and will continue until EPA completes the removal action.

4. I have been notified that these actions by EPA are undertaken pursuant to its response authority under Section 104(a) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act ("CERCLA" or "Superfund"), 42 U.S.C. Section 9604(a)

5. I have been notified that parties found responsible pursuant to Section 107(a) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C.§ 9607(a), may be liable for all costs EPA incurs in connection with the response which are not inconsistent with the National Contingency Plan ("NCP"), at 40 CFR Part 300. However, my signature on this Access Authorization does not constitute an admission of liability under Section 107(a) of CERCLA, 42 U.S.C. § 9607(a).
