New Program to Make College More Affordable

On January 4, 2007, the University of Louisville unveiled a special program called the **Cardinal Covenant**, a program aimed at students from low-income families to fund their education. Beginning with the Fall 2007 semester, eligible students will receive the full cost of tuition, room, board and books until they graduate as long as they meet all program guidelines.

To qualify, students must have an annual income at or below 150% of federal poverty guidelines, be residents of Kentucky, meet all admission & Pell Grant eligibility require-

ments, maintain satisfactory grades and graduate within five years. Students in this program will be able to graduate from UofL debt free.

This program is the first of its kind in Kentucky and modeled after the University of North Carolina's Carolina Covenant Program, which began in 2003.

Cardinal Covenant Income Guidelines:

- A family of 4 with an annual income of \$30,000 or less
- Single, self-supporting student earning \$14,700 a year or less
