Please submit your essay as well as an optional one page resume either electronically to cultural@louisville.edu, or in person at the Cultural Center (across the street from the College of Education, adjacent to Miller Hall, and to the west of the University Club and the Red Barn).
- You will be contacted the following week with the status of your application and there will be a meeting for introductions on Friday, February 26 from 12-1pm.
