**Course Description:**

**Check-in: 8:30 a.m. at ULSD (For driving and parking directions, please see the website)**

**Course: 9 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. for four (4) days; usually Saturdays/Sundays**

**Credit: 24 Hours (CEU)**

This course is designed for dental auxiliaries who would like advanced training in restorative dentistry. The course will provide pre-clinical proficiency in restorative procedures and will include placement and finishing of amalgam and composite restorations to clinical competency. This program is presented **in two weekend sessions** with an “intersession” in the participant’s dental office. The course features numerous lectures and audio visual presentations in the ULSD Dental Education Center. The hands-on segments of the course are held in the state-of-the-art ULSD Simulation Clinic. The final weekend will include a pre-clinical proficiency and a written exam.

**Course Objectives:**

At the conclusion of this course, participants will have a working understanding of:

- Tooth morphology
- Various restorative dental materials, including bases, liners, composites, flowable composites and amalgam
- The selection of appropriate rubber dam clamps
- Efficient rubber dam placement techniques
- The proper selection and placement of various types of matrices
- The selection and placement of wedges
- The considerations for obtaining proper tooth contacts
- Techniques for the placement of bases and liners
- Techniques for the placement of anterior and posterior composite restorations
- Techniques for the placement of amalgam restorations
- Effective finishing and polishing techniques of composite and amalgam restorations
- Placement of temporary filling materials

**Along with a registration form, the participant is required to have: (1) a written letter (on letterhead) of support from the sponsoring dentist which states that the person has at least one year of chair-side dental assisting experience. (Please use those exact words.) ATA graduates’ letter should only state that they are currently employed at a specific office (must be on letterhead). Also, (2) a copy of the front and back of the participant’s current CPR card is necessary.**
