Students will prepare for travel to the beautiful city of Wrocław, Poland to volunteer during the 2017 World Games. The World Games feature more than 30 non-Olympic sports in such diverse disciplines as beach handball to sport climbing to casting. Having absorbed Bohemian, Austrian and Prussian influences, the city of Wrocław has a unique architectural and cultural make-up, symbolized by its magnificent market square (Rynek). Wrocław's location on the Odra River, with its 12 islands, 130 bridges and riverside parks, is idyllic, and the beautifully preserved Cathedral Island is a treat for lovers of Gothic architecture. Wrocław is Poland's fourth-largest city and the major industrial, commercial and educational center for the region.

Students and Faculty will work in a variety of roles in support of the event including the Media Center, Field of Play, and Team Services. Prior to beginning our volunteer experience, we will explore Wrocław and the history/culture of the region.
