Scholarships Available: Each student accepted for the International Learning 2017 experience will receive a CEHD scholarship (\$500-\$700) to be applied to the trip costs listed above. Please note that the scholarship will not be applied until the student has paid their portion of the trip costs.

Experience: Students will have an opportunity to discuss mental health issues in Ireland with local University faculty and community mental health providers, the history of the mental health field in Ireland, and current issues that impact society at large as well as professionals in the field. Students will visit professional institutions in art therapy and counseling and local mental health treatment facilities. The International Learning experience partners with several institutions in Cork, and Dublin to make this experience an enriching one for our students and their programs: The University College Cork and the Cork Institute of Technology in Cork, the Crawford College of Art and Design at CIT, and Trinity College in Dublin. We have made every effort to build a meaningful experience for our students.

Along with formal academic experiences, we will have the chance to visit some of the beautiful places in Ireland—Cobh, Ring of Kerry, Blarney Castle, Cliffs of Moher, Newgrange, just to name a few.
