Brief Course Description	Prerequisites: Admission to the Alternate Certification Program. This seminar course provides cohort members continued support for portfolio development, implementation of their action research/reflection project, and completion of the second semester of the Kentucky Teacher Internship Program.
Programs that Require this Course	Alternative Certification Middle/Secondary MAT
DESCRIPTION OF FIELD COMPONENT	
Number and Distribution of Hours in the Field	35-40 hours per week Candidates are working as the teacher of record in their own classroom as a part of the Alternative route program.
Purpose(s) of Field Experiences	The Alt Cert candidates work as the teacher of record as they are working towards teacher certification. The field experience includes every responsibility required of full time teachers
Hallmark Assessment Task (HAT) (only if Field based)	Action Research Project
Description of field-based assignments assessed in course (other than HAT)	Candidates serve as the teacher of record therefore assuming all teacher roles and responsibilities
Additional experiences while at field placement	Candidates are involved in the KTIP process during this second year of the Alt Cert program and will have field experience requirements aligned with KTIP/TPA
Cooperating Teacher Role and Required Support	Each candidate is assigned a KTIP committee consisting of a resource teacher, local school administrator and Teacher Educator. The KTIP committee is required to complete three formal observations and meet with the candidate at least 4 times throughout the course of the year.
