Communication in English (IELP 096-01)

Course Description

Communication in English (CIE) is a 3 credit, non-degree class. CIE is designed to help non-native speakers of English (advanced proficiency) become more effective communicators in academic, professional and social situations. Applicants must be out of high school.



Class instruction will focus on activities that promote conversational fluency, understanding of English vocabulary and idioms, and the acquisition of linguistic strategies needed in professional interactions such as discussions and presentations.

For Fall semester, students will attend class Wednesday nights, from 7:00 p.m. until 9:45 p.m. Each class has a limit of 15 students.

The program tuition and fees are \$675.00. Course materials, determined by the instructor, are not included in this fee. UofL may also charge an international student fee, depending on your visa. **Tuition and fees must be paid in full before the first class.**

How To Apply



- Fill out the CIE application.
- Mail, fax, email, or hand-deliver your application to the IESL office in Strickler Hall, Room 207 (Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.). Applicants are accepted on a first-come-first-serve basis (from the date they are received).
- After you receive your letter of acceptance, pay your bill before the first night of class.

Important

Turning in an application does not register you for the class. A letter will be mailed to you verifying your enrollment and notifying you of the class location.
