

Help Fight MS

If you are a female with relapsing-remitting multiple sclerosis, you may be eligible to participate in the following research study (IRB #08.0172) being conducted by Dr. Cynthia Corbitt, Dept. of Biology, University of Louisville, Louisville KY.

Exploratory Study of the Timing of Multiple Sclerosis Symptoms

Eligible participants should:

- Have a diagnosis of relapsing-remitting MS
- Be pre-menopausal (not entered menopause or had a hysterectomy)
- Be neither pregnant nor nursing
- Have not been treated with steroids within the last 30 days
- Have not used experimental MS therapies

The study will be completed by phone and by mail. Participants will be asked to complete a general health information form. Participants will also be asked to record their general health information (including MS symptoms) for the past thirty days and then will be given a health diary to complete over the next three months. Subjects will be compensated for their time and inconvenience.

Information gathered in this study may help researchers better understand MS.
