Working in conjunction with the Planning and Budget Committee (P&B), APC has recommended the Distilled Spirits Business Certificate proposed by the College of Business (COB) for the full senate to vote in the March 6th monthly meeting. APC has invited Kristen Lucas, the Certificate Program Coordinator from COB to the meeting for a short Q&A session. Immediately after that, FS will vote on the proposal.

APC has provided input to P&B on the final version of the proposed Center for Archeology and Cultural Heritage (CACHe).

In addition, COB has another certificate proposal in the works – Business Analytics which is a companion to their recently approved MS. So far APC has not received any of these proposals for review.
