KEN TERRILL MEMORIAL AWARD 2011-2012

APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 22, 2011

The University of Louisville College of Arts and Sciences announces the 2011-2012 Ken Terrill Memorial Award. The award will be made to help defray the college expenses of a U of L undergraduate student who has demonstrated leadership in or service to the gay, lesbian, and bisexual community of U of L or the greater Louisville metropolitan area.

Ken Terrill, known by students and faculty alike as “KT”, was an Associate Professor of Theatre Arts at the University for seventeen years. He was also a long-time advocate for gay, lesbian, and bisexual students. He was a faculty advisor for the Gay, Lesbian, or Bisexual Alliance (GLOBAL) from its inception until his death in March of 1994. The award was endowed by KT’s family and friends as a lasting tribute to his commitment to students and the gay, lesbian and bisexual community.

One or more awards of \$500 will be made for the 2011-2012 academic year.

Undergraduate students may apply by submitting a letter discussing their leadership and service in the gay, lesbian, and bisexual community. A copy of an unofficial transcript and two letters of recommendation should accompany the application. One recommendation must come from a member of the faculty or staff of the University. A completed application form (available in the Arts & Sciences Advising Center, the Arts & Sciences Dean's Office, and the Office of Financial Aid) should be attached to the student’s letter. Electronic applications will not be accepted and incomplete applications will not be considered.

Deadline for applications is March 22, 2011. Applications and letters of recommendation should be sent to Dr. Roselle Taylor, Assistant Dean, College of Arts and Sciences, University of Louisville, Louisville, Ky 40292.
