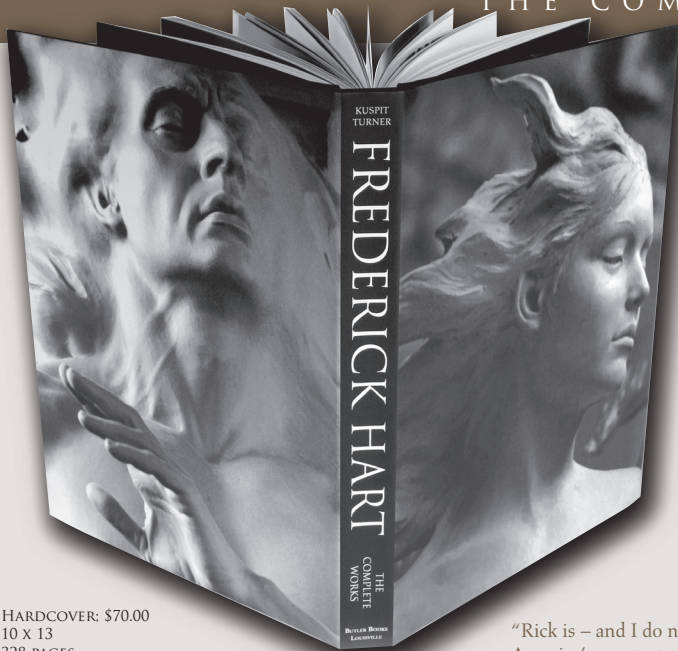

In 2004, Michael Novak wrote, "The work of Frederick Hart is changing the world of art." Creating powerful and inspirational sculpture for such widely divergent venues as Washington National Cathedral and the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Hart led a charge to revive figurative art. Drawing inspiration from great sculptors such as Michelangelo and Bernini, Hart sought to extend the power of figurative art into the modern era.

FREDERICK HART: THE COMPLETE WORKS is a richly deserved honor for Hart and a valuable resource for art historians and collectors. This magnificent volume is resplendent with more than 246 color plates and 136 black-and-white illustrations, and provides full specifications and documentation for the artist's 204 sculptural works.

A fully illustrated appendix describes the processes he used for casting in various media, and the methods used to translate his clay models into stone. Essays by art historian Donald Kuspit and poet-scholar Frederick Turner demonstrate how Hart's impassioned, innovative art and its philosophy at once merge humanist, transcendental, and romantic ideas, and offer compelling insight into the importance of Hart's sculpture. An essay by Lindy Lain Hart about her husband's creative process and a memoir by their son Lain further enhance the book. Last, Hart's biography and journey from obscurity to renown are plotted in a richly illustrated chronology.

The release of FREDERICK HART: THE COMPLETE WORKS, coinciding with an important exhibition at the University of Louisville from September to November 2007, confirms Hart's well-earned place in the pantheon of American figurative sculptors.
