Human Development Company (HDC) is an Employee Assistance Program designed to provide short-term counseling services (eight sessions per issue) to you or anyone living in your residence. The services are completely confidential and free of charge. This benefit is not associated with your insurance plan, so there are no co-pays or deductibles associated with the service.

The Employee Assistance Program is designed to help you and your household family members obtain assistance on a confidential and professional basis. Employees may access these services to discuss such issues as depression, anxiety, substance abuse problems, marital strife, or conflict between you and another employee, for example. No problem is too big or too small, and the staff of HDC possess the special training and experience required to effectively assess a wide variety of issues.

In addition, a wide variety of locations are offered throughout Kentucky and the United States for your convenience. Business hours are from 9-5; however, evening and Saturday appointments are also available.
