Course Description/Purpose

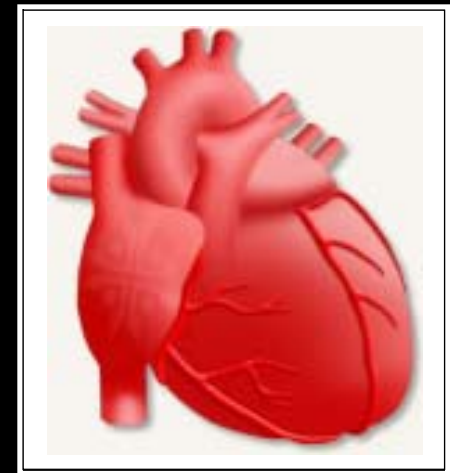
