Airport Information

There are three airports located near NSF: Reagan National Airport (DCA), Dulles International Airport (IAD), and the Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI).

The closest airport to NSF is the Reagan National Airport (DCA), which is approximately 7 miles away. <http://www.nsf.gov/about/visit/national.jsp>

The Dulles International Airport (IAD) is approximately 25 miles away. <http://www.nsf.gov/about/visit/dulles.jsp>

The Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI) is approximately 39 miles away. <http://www.nsf.gov/about/visit/bwi.jsp>

Transit

There is a train that directly connects BWI to the Union Station, which is the central Amtrak station in the Washington D.C. area, and costs approximately \$8.75 for a round trip. From Union Station, NSF visitors should take the Red Line to Metro Center, transfer to the Orange Line, and get off at Ballston-Marymount University. For more information visit:

Driving Directions

- Exiting Union Station follow Louisiana Ave, NW proceeding south to Constitution Ave.
- Turn right on Constitution Ave to signs to Route 66 West, crossing the Teddy Roosevelt Bridge and staying in the left lane.
- Exit I-66 West at Glebe Road (Approximately 2 miles).
- Turn left at the end of off-ramp onto Glebe Road.
- Proceed 1/2 mile (4 stop lights) to Wilson Blvd.
- Turn left on Wilson Blvd.
- Turn left on N. Stuart Drive.
