Criminal Justice Internship Insurance Information and Liability Waiver

1. No Criminal Justice Internship agency assumes liability for any injury the student might sustain while undergoing the Internship.
2. All Internship students will be expected to take out the student health insurance policy, sponsored by the University Student Government, unless they already have an insurance policy affording the same coverage.
3. Internship students who do not have insurance should make their own contracts prior to enrollment. Students who are enrolling for summer terms may qualify for the student policy, provided they were enrolled the term prior to Internship. It is the responsibility of the individual student to work out the details and requirements.
