

Part-Time Practicum Faculty Award

One award is presented each year at the May commencement, during the Kent School convocation, to a part-time practicum faculty member for excellence in teaching and advocating for students' education. This award recognizes the complexity of the role of serving to promote the integration of the masters' curriculum with actual practice in the community. The practicum faculty is a liaison among the campus-based faculty and courses, the agency-based supervisors and the student. Practicum faculty must ensure the student applies the curriculum teachings while advocating for the learning opportunities and students' educational needs, when there are competing practice approaches and values between "town and gown." The recipient is selected based on the ratings from the annual evaluation of the practicum experience by students and agency supervisors, along with the faculty's record of advocacy activities for students' education. The faculty member receives an individual plaque and her/his name is added to a master plaque in the lobby of the Kent School.

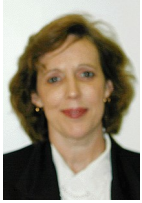
