

Scholarship Information and Application

Kent School of Social Work, University of Louisville

One of the major goals in the Kent School is to assure a diverse student body and to provide all students with a multicultural experience. These educational objectives are designed to train professional social workers for practice in a context demanding sensitivity to a plurality of views and concerns. To achieve this end, minority students and students with diversity experience will be given strong consideration. A limited number of scholarships are available to qualified students for graduate study in social work. The scholarships are based on financial need and academic merit and potential. The number and amount of awards vary, just as the amount and availability of funds vary each year.

To be considered for a scholarship from Kent School, a **NEW student** must:

- 1) meet the *Traditional* application to Kent School deadline (**May 15th**),
- 2) file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) www.fafsa.ed.gov with the Student Financial Aid Office. The priority deadline for filing this form is March 15 prior to the fall semester for which you plan to be considered.
- 3) submit a two-page essay if required (see below), and
- 4) submit the scholarship application by the deadline of **May 15th** of each year you plan to be considered. The exception to this is the **Jan 31** deadline if you wish to be considered for the Hartford PPP Scholarship (Gerontology Specialization).

To be considered for a scholarship from Kent School, a **RETURNING student** must:

- 1) have a 3.00 GPA,
- 2) file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) www.fafsa.ed.gov with the Student Financial Aid Office. The priority deadline for filing this form is March 15 prior to the fall semester for which you plan to be considered.
- 3) submit a two-page essay if required (see below), and
- 4) submit the scholarship application by the deadline of **May 15th** of each year you plan to be considered. The exception to this is the **Jan 31** deadline if you wish to be considered for the Hartford PPP Scholarship (Gerontology Specialization).

If chosen for a scholarship award, the student will be expected to:

- 1) maintain a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and
- 2) remain in full time status (9 credit hours per semester) throughout the time frame specified on the scholarship award letter.

IMPORTANT: A student must apply or re-apply for scholarships each year by the May 15th deadline in order to be considered for that year, regardless of any prior award. The FAFSA must also be filed each year.

All applicants will be notified in writing once awards have been made, usually around July 1. The guidelines for the determination of financial awards are set by the Scholarship Committee. Applicants are strongly encouraged to develop resources to finance their graduate education with the assistance of the Financial Aid Office of the University of Louisville. This office administers a variety of programs to help remove financial barriers. ___ **Maude Ainslie Scholarship** Requires a two-page essay addressing personal and educational goals.

___ **Martha Davis Scholarship** Requires a two-page essay addressing plans to provide social services in rural areas of Kentucky.

___ **Lipetz Scholarship** This scholarship is only available to students in their advanced practicum year. The student must be placed in a practicum that has an aging, policy or legislative focus. ****Gerontology Specialization Scholarship** Students interested in this scholarship must apply to the Kent School by a special early January 31st. Students who make this deadline can complete an online scholarship application that will ask you to submit your resume and a 4-page essay, addressing your interest in aging and your specific goals for practicum. These surveys will go directly to the Gerontology Specialization Coordinator, Dr. Sharon Bowland and you be contacted for an interview.
