Registration: Volunteers will be present from 7:30 am to 11:00 am for college representatives, student and counselor registration.

Promesa Mentoring: A 1 and 1/2 hour training is required; volunteers will learn to assist Latino, immigrant, refugee, and ESL students plan their “roads to college.” During the fair, Promesa Mentors will mentor students one-on-one as they plan for college using the “Mi Camino a la Universidad guide.” Promesa mentoring will take place from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm.
