The Project

The Art Library has a number of special collections, mostly the papers of local artists and architects, that have not been processed by an archivist. Although some have minimal finding aids to help researchers, none of them have complete and thorough finding aids in a standardized format and available on the web.

A trained archivist would be hired to process the collections, prepare thorough finding aids and mount them on the Libraries' website. This person would also identify and scan images in the collections to contribute to the Libraries' digital collections website (<http://digital.library.louisville.edu>).

Benefits

Students, faculty and researchers, both within and outside U of L will be able to reap the benefit of these collections, enhancing both their research and the reputation of the University as a research institution.

Cost

The total investment required for this project is \$6,400. This represents the cost of a qualified archivist at \$20 per hour for a total of 320 hours.
