



Research Fellowship Fund Special Collections/University Archives

Background:

Scholars pursuing significant scholarly projects, as well as graduate students at all levels, typically must travel to use archival material for their projects. Established research centers, particularly those at libraries within the Association of Research Libraries, frequently provide travel or research stipends in order to encourage and support use of their collections by scholars.

The Project

Cost

Required minimum amount to establish a separate endowment at the University of Louisville is \$10,000. Once established, supplemental donations may be contributed to this account.
