

Dissertation Abstracts (and Full-Text) through ProQuest Digital Dissertations



Dissertations from 1997-present are now available in electronic form at no charge. To retrieve a dissertation, please follow the instructions below. Pre-1997 dissertation abstracts can also be searched but not downloaded for free. To access a pre-1997 dissertation, use Interlibrary-Loan. University of Louisville dissertations and theses are available in print format going back to 1909. They are located on the 3rd floor and are arranged by date and author's last name.

Step 1: Go to the main library web page: <http://library.louisville.edu/>

Step 2: Click on [Full Text Databases A-Z](#) (under the Articles section of the page).

Step 3: Scroll down until you find [Digital Dissertations](#).

Step 4: Enter your search. You have several options:

A. To search for a particular author:

Type the author's last/family name first, then a comma and the first name if you know it. Change the drop down box to Author (AU)

B. To search for a dissertation by title: Change the drop down box to Title (TI)

C. To search for a dissertation by subject or a particular university: Change the drop down box to subject (SU) or school (SC).

Step 7: Click on the Checkout button. You'll find this at the bottom of the screen.

Step 8: At the next screen, you'll be asked to fill in some contact information. After that, you'll be asked to review the information and submit your order. You can still cancel at this point. It will usually take about 5 minutes to prepare your order and you will be contacted via e-mail or fax. You'll be given a website and pin number which you will use to download the PDF file. Please note **this file will NOT fit on a floppy disk**. You'll need to download it to the hard drive (C:) of your computer and you'll need the Adobe Acrobat software to view it and to print it.
