What is Grove Music?

Grove Music Online is an integrated music resource available on the web, including the full-text of:

- *The New Grove Dictionary of Music and Musicians*, 2nd ed.
- *The New Grove Dictionary of Opera*
- *The New Grove Dictionary of Jazz*, 2nd ed.

Articles from the *New Grove Opera* and *New Grove Jazz* are indicated in result or article lists with icons.

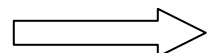
Articles from the *New Grove Opera* appear in a burgundy frame-set, articles from the *New Grove Jazz* appear in a purple frame-set, compared to the articles of the main dictionary, which appear in a blue frame.

Searching

- **Basic search** – enter a term in the search box, which appears in the top left-hand side of every page.
- **Article search** – search for a term only within the article you are viewing (useful with longer articles).
- **Advanced Search**
 - **Full-text** –search the entire dictionary text for any mention of a particular term.
You can choose from 3 search modes:
 - Concept – e.g. “state” will also match “province,” “country,” and “land”
 - Pattern – e.g. “Orpheus” will also match “Orfeo”
 - Boolean – e.g. “Quantz AND Berlin” will match articles that include both terms
 - **Biographies** – searches only the biographical entries using the following alone or in combination:
 - Date of birth
 - Date of death
 - Place of birth
 - Place of Death
 - Occupation
 - Nationality
 - **Bibliographies** – searches only the bibliographies of entries (e.g. just citations to writings by or about Wagner)
 - **Links** – searches for links to external websites that are featured in Grove Music online.
 - **Contributors** – use this search to locate all articles written by a particular contributor.
 - **Works-Lists** – this option enables you to focus a search on works-lists only.

Browsing (‘Browse’)

- **Articles** – lists the headings of all the articles in the dictionary alphabetically.
- **Abbreviations** – you can browse general abbreviations or library sigla.
- **Contributors** – displays an alphabetical list of contributors.
- **Index** – browse by clicking on a letter to view the list of index points beginning with that letter.



Exploring ('Explore')

This feature enables you to explore and find articles using a biography subject classification.

Top-level groups:

- Composers
- Performers
- printers and publishers
- writers

Notes: This feature is still in development.

Tips

- **Search navigation bar** – use the search navigation bar, which appears below the article text, to move through other articles in your search results without having to return to the results lists.
- **Alternate spellings** – Grove Music uses British spellings. To search for alternate spellings, type an exclamation mark (!) after the word and surround with quotation marks ('theater!' will find 'theater' and 'theatre')
- **Wildcards** – use wildcards to match a range of characters when searching
 - ? matches any single character (Sm?th will find Smith and Smyth)
 - * matches any number of characters (cor* will find cor, cornet, cornett, cornon, cornophone, cornu)
 - [] matches any single character from within the brackets (Sm[iy]th will find Smith or Smyth); specifying a numerical range using a hyphen will find numbers within that range (199[0-9] will match dates from 1990 to 1999).
 - ~ preceding a search term matches words that sound alike (~chikovsky will find Tchaikovsky).
- **Cross references** – cross-references within articles are highlighted and appear in small caps.
- **Abbreviations** – enter the abbreviation you want to find in the "Find Abbrevs" box in the navigation bar across the top of the screen.
- **Table of contents** – each article has a table of contents, which appears to the left of the article. You can use this table of contents to navigate to various sections of the article.
- **Images** – unfortunately not all images from the print edition appear in the online version due to copyright restrictions.
