- Here at the University of Louisville the Reference Department is testing out the creation of *videos* to promote library collections and services *in an effort to truly show that IT is happening here in the library!*

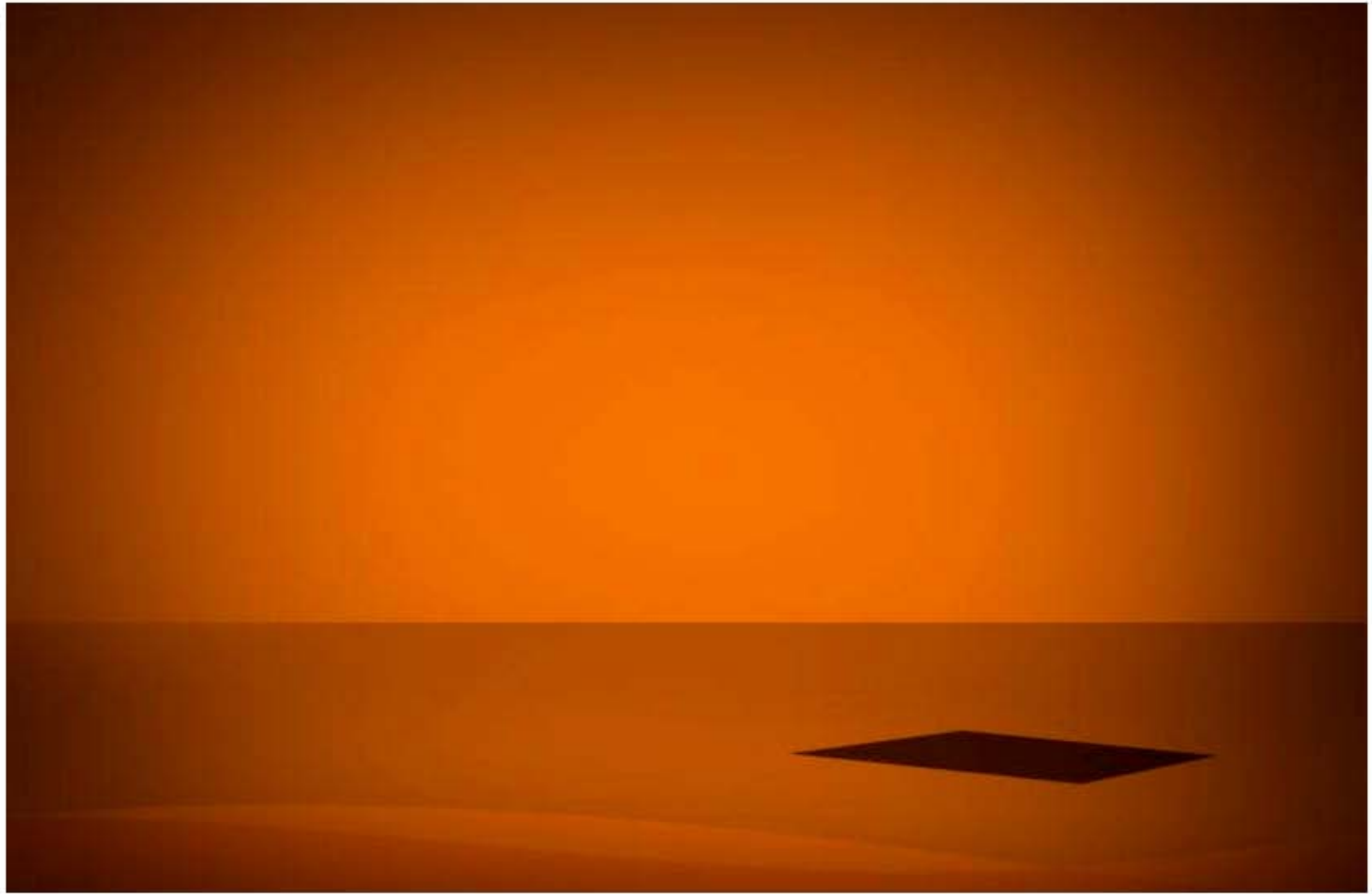
