### Exporting Ovid Citations to Citation Management Software

Using the **Ovid Direct Export** feature will automatically activate most reference management software, including Reference Manager, EndNote and ProCite.

After executing a search in Ovid, use the **Citation Manager** commands located at the end of the Titles Display on the **Main Search Page**. Note: Reference Manager and End Note do not need to be open. They will start automatically.

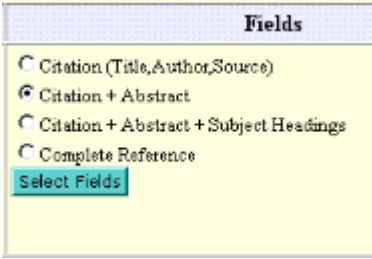

Follow these steps to select and export search results:

	<h3>Citations</h3> <p>Lets you choose which records to output into your reference management software. You have four options:</p> <p>From the <b>Titles Display</b> format you can:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Save only citations you marked (selected) while browsing the search results.</li><li>2. Choose all the records being displayed on the page you are viewing. .</li><li>3. Choose all the citations in the search set you retrieved, up to a maximum of 200 citations.</li><li>4. Choose a Range of citations.</li></ol>

	<p><b>Fields</b> lets you select how much information to include for each citation. For best results, always choose <b>Complete Reference</b></p>
	<p><b>Citation Format</b> Determines the appearance of your downloaded file. You always choose <b>Direct Export</b>.</p>
	<p><b>Action</b> Choose the <b>Save</b> button. Follow the instructions below to save your citations into a new or existing .rmd database file.</p>

After you SAVE, there will be a pause in the operation and you will be prompted to choose a place to save your downloaded citations.

Choose a database in which to save your citations. It is generally recommended that you create a separate folder, and use only one database to save all of your references, as shown in the Reference Manager example.
