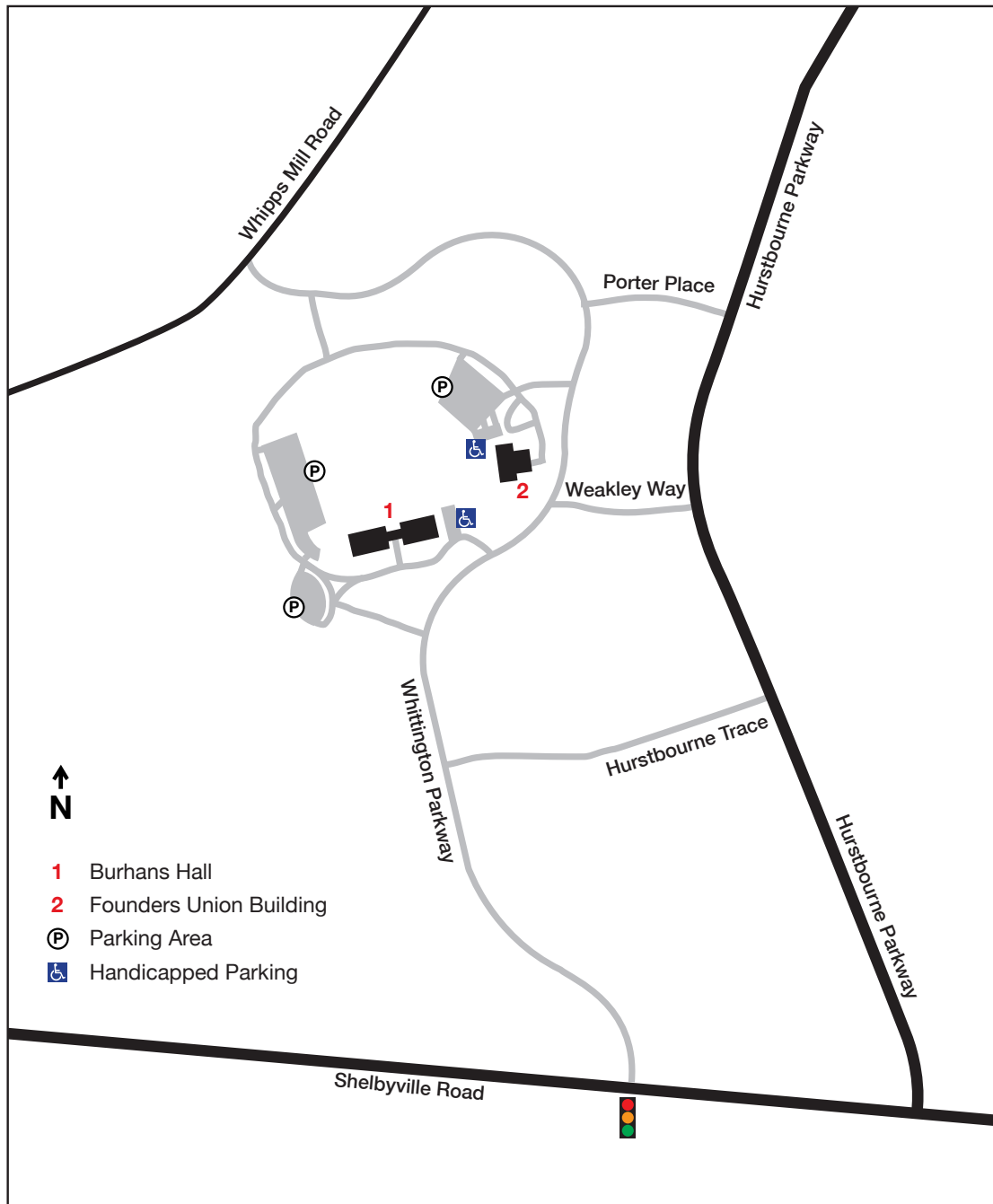


University of Louisville, Shelby Campus 9001 Shelbyville Rd, Louisville, KY 40222

The main entrance is at the intersection of Whittington Parkway and Shelbyville Road. You may also enter Shelby Campus from Whipps Mill Road or from one of the three new entrances off Hurstbourne Parkway (Porter Place, Weakley Way, or Hurstbourne Trace). Please see the map for these entrances.

Directions to the main entrance of Shelby Campus

From I-65 North: Take the I-264 (Watterson expressway) East exit. After traveling approximately 7 miles, take Exit 20A (Shelbyville Rd. E, US 60/Middletown). Shelby Campus is approx. 2 miles down on the left at the stop light at Whittington Parkway.

From I-65 South: Take the I-264 (Watterson expressway) East exit. Follow the directions above.

From Airport: Take the I-264 (Watterson expressway) East exit. Follow the directions above

From I-64 East: Take Exit 12B (I-264 East/Watterson expressway). Then take Exit 20A (Shelbyville Rd. East, US 60/Middletown). Shelby Campus is approx. 2 miles down on the left at the stop light at Whittington Parkway.

From I-64 West: Take Exit 15 (Hurstbourne Pkwy, Middletown/Jeffersontown/ Shelby Campus). Turn right on Hurstbourne Pkwy. Travel approximately 2 miles to the intersection of Shelbyville Rd. (US 60). Turn left on to Shelbyville Rd. Shelby Campus is approx. 1/4 mile on the right at the stop light at Whittington Parkway.

I-71 South: Take the I-264 (Watterson expressway) West exit. This is a left turn. Take the Shelbyville Road East exit (US 60/Middletown). Shelby Campus is approx. 2 miles down on the left at the stop light at Whittington Parkway.

Parking:

***Burhans Hall** – Parking lots are at the west side (left) of the building. Handicapped parking spaces are on the east side (right) of the building (See map)

***Founder's Union** - Parking is available in the lot behind the building. Handicapped spaces are in this lot. (See map)
