Subject: Homberger Student Travel Fellowships

Colleagues,

Dissemination of research results at national and international meetings is a critical part of the Department's research endeavor. It also is an extremely important part of the education process. As such the department has created the Alfred and Iva Homberger Travel Awards.

Eligibility:

BMB Graduate students who:

1. have successfully completed all course requirements, AND
2. have successfully defended Exam 1 AND Exam 2 by the end of year 3 of their program, AND
3. are the presenting author of a poster or of a platform talk.

Selection criteria:

1. Regularly attend BMB seminars (a sign-up sheet will be located outside the seminar room beginning January, 2011).
2. Matching funds provided by mentor and/or other sources.

Number of Awards:

I anticipate that up to 10 awards could be made each year. Awards will be determined by the BMB Research Committee in consultation with the departmental chair. The maximum award will be \$500, however other amounts will be considered under exceptional conditions. Only one award per student.
