

University of Louisville HIV/AIDS Online Course - Instructions

Incoming residents are required by the state of Kentucky to pass an AIDS education course before beginning their residency. If the incoming residents wish to take U of L's online AIDS course to satisfy this requirement, they may do so for no charge.

They just need to go to <http://www.chse.louisville.edu/b76hz43.html> and follow the instructions. If they do not complete the course in one session, they may return to it as many times as necessary using the above address. They will not be asked to log in at any point during the course; they simply need to go to that page, which is not password protected, and follow the instructions.

After completing the online course, they will enter their name and social security number (if applicable) and be directed to an online certificate which proves they have taken and passed the course. They will need to print this certificate for their records. It will not be e-mailed to them unless they specifically contact us at chse@louisville.edu and request this service.

If they need technical support for the course, they can call 502-852-6296 or e-mail chse@louisville.edu. Technical support does not mean an explanation of how to access or return to the course without paying; that procedure is described above. Technical support covers issues such as "I can't get the video to play," "I can't download the handout," etc.

Please note that this course is only free to incoming residents and fellows for the 2009-2010 academic year. Please do not distribute the above web address to anyone except incoming residents and fellows for the 2009-2010 academic year. Should anyone other than incoming residents/fellows obtain this address and take the course without paying, their certificate will be invalidated and their licensure board notified.

Faculty members and anyone else who does not qualify for the free course must pay a fee in order to take it (\$55 for physicians and dentists and \$30 for all other healthcare professionals) by going to <http://www.chse.louisville.edu/aidsintro3.htm> and following the instructions.
