

University of Louisville Domestic Violence Online Course - Instructions

The University of Louisville's online Domestic Violence course provides an in-depth look at the medical, social and legal issues surrounding domestic violence. It fulfills the domestic violence continuing education requirement (Kentucky Regulatory Statute 194) for health care professionals in the state of Kentucky.

They just need to go to <http://www.chse.louisville.edu/dviolencecourse2.html> and follow the instructions. If they do not complete the course in one session, they may return to it as many times as necessary using the above address. They will not be asked to log in at any point during the course; they simply need to go to that page, which is not password protected, and follow the instructions.

After completing the online course, they will enter their name and social security number (if applicable) and be directed to an online certificate which proves they have taken and passed the course. They will need to print this certificate for their records. It will not be e-mailed to them unless they specifically contact us at chse@louisville.edu and request this service.

If they need technical support for the course, they can call 502-852-6296 or e-mail chse@louisville.edu. Technical support does not mean an explanation of how to access or return to the course without paying; that procedure is described above. Technical support covers issues such as "I can't get the video to play," "I can't download the handout," etc.

Please note that this course is only free to incoming residents and fellows for the 2009-2010 academic year. Please do not distribute the above web address to anyone except incoming residents and fellows for the 2009-2010 academic year. Should anyone other than incoming residents/fellows obtain this address and take the course without paying, their certificate will be invalidated and their licensure board notified.
