Guidelines for Earning Language Credits

UofL students may earn up to 18 hours of credit for prior language study completed at the high school level in French, German, Latin, Russian and Spanish. To earn these credits, students must take the placement exam and successfully complete the course into which they were placed.

The placement tests may not be used to earn credit if the student already has received college or university level credit in that language elsewhere or has completed a course in that language at this university.

When a student places into a course higher than 121, **credit toward graduation will be awarded for those language courses by-passed only if the student completes successfully the language class into which she/he is placed.** Any credit earned by placement testing will be posted on the student's record only after completion of a regular semester of full-time study (or 12 semester hours) at the University of Louisville. Students should not enroll for credit in a course they have successfully bypassed through placement examination without prior consultation with the language coordinator.
