Inclement Weather

If Jefferson County Public Schools or U of L closes due to bad weather conditions, then we are closed. If you have any doubt, contact your teacher directly. Lessons canceled due to inclement weather will be rescheduled. Oldham Arts Center will follow Oldham County Public School closings.

Missed Classes

Notification by the student of inability to attend a private lesson does not excuse payment for the lesson, which must be paid for, whether taken or missed. At the teacher's discretion, unavoidable absences will be made up when possible. There is no refund for missed group classes. If a teacher must cancel a class, that class will be made up. There is a week at the end of each quarter devoted to make-up lessons.

Registration

Registration must be complete (i.e. completed registration form and tuition paid) before the first lesson of each semester. The teacher is not allowed to teach any student who is not registered.

Suzuki Method Music Training

CELLO - FLUTE - GUITAR - PIANO - VIOLA - VIOLIN

The SUZUKI METHOD of instruction is based on the philosophy that musical ability can be developed if nurtured in a loving and supportive environment. Initial playing is by ear, using the "Mother Tongue" approach to learning; and therefore one learns to play by imitating musical sounds as heard on the Suzuki recordings. The Suzuki approach relies strongly on the cooperative relationship of the parent, teacher, and student in a pleasant, yet disciplined enterprise.
