Biographical Leadership Summary

Administration

For three years, Dr. Chlebowy served as the Director of the BSN Programs at the University of Louisville. Her primary responsibilities included hiring new faculty to teach in the undergraduate program, completing workload assignments, overseeing the undergraduate curriculum and curriculum-related issues, completing annual program reports, working collaboratively with the faculty to address student issues, addressing student issues related to academic performance, and participating in orientation sessions for newly admitted students in the traditional, accelerated, and RN-BSN programs. She provided administrative support for faculty serving on subcommittees at the School of Nursing and leadership in the planning of the Transitions Ceremonies. Dr. Chlebowy attended the annual AACN Baccalaureate Leadership Conference meetings, participated in Academic Leadership Workshops at the University of Louisville, and attended monthly Associate Dean and Undergraduate Dean Meetings at the University of Louisville. She was also selected as a Fellow in the American Association of Colleges of Nursing Leadership for Academic Nursing Program for 2012-2013. She is presently Coordinator of the Research Scholar Program and Director of the Master's Entry Professional Nursing Program and the Master of Science in Nursing Program at the University of Louisville School of Nursing.

Teaching

Throughout her academic career, Dr. Chlebowy has taught in traditional and accelerated BSN programs. She has modified courses to become hybrid courses comprised of both face-to-face and online instructional components. She has taught adult health nursing, theory, and research courses with other faculty colleagues using a variety of teaching methods (e.g., panel discussions, small group work, and in-class group assignments) to enhance student learning. In addition, she has had the opportunity to teach various on-line courses in a RN-BSN program. Dr. Chlebowy continues to provide ongoing mentorship for undergraduate students as they engage in independent research and scholarly activities.

Dr. Chlebowy has also taught graduate courses (e.g., theory, research, health promotion and population health, and pathophysiology) in her academic career. She recently served as a faculty mentor for doctoral students enrolled at the University of Louisville School of Public Health and Information Sciences and the University of Louisville School of Nursing as they engaged in research and scholarly activities. In addition, she has served as a dissertation committee chair for a PhD student at the University of Louisville School of Nursing and committee member for a student at the University of Louisville College of Education and Human Development; she has also served as a committee member for a DNP student at Yale University. She continues to mentor graduate research assistants at the University of Louisville School of Nursing. She is

presently a primary professor for two PhD students at the University of Louisville School of Nursing.

Research/Scholarship

As a nurse scientist, Dr. Chlebowy is committed to promoting research and scholarship activities in the academic setting. During her tenure at the University of Louisville, she was instrumental in establishing an interprofessional research team in execution of these activities. She and her interprofessional team received intramural and extramural funding to conduct their research. Dr. Chlebowy has published in refereed journals and presented extensively at national, regional, and local conferences. She has been recognized internationally for her research expertise and was recently invited as a grant reviewer for the National Institute for Social Care and Health Research, Welsh government and the Israel Science Foundation. Dr. Chlebowy has special interest in mentoring undergraduate and graduate students, our future scientists, to promote their involvement in interprofessional research and scholarship activities. In 2016, she served as a faculty mentor for a visiting scholar from Wenzhou Medical University of China.
