## University of Louisville School of Nursing Application for Guaranteed Early Admission (GEA)

Guaranteed Early Admission is a competitive process. Twenty spaces are reserved each academic year for first-year, full-time college freshmen from the University of Louisville, who enter the University of Louisville in the Fall semester. First year college freshmen are eligible to apply for the GEA program during their first year of enrollment at UofL. Students must be enrolled full time during these two semesters. Deadline is **April 1**<sup>st</sup> each year. GEA applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Successful completion of NURS 101.
- Successful completion of the first year of full-time coursework with a minimum 3.0.
- Completion of Chem105 and BIO 102 (or their equivalents) with a minimum grade of B.

GEA is <u>not open</u> to transfer students. Admission to Upper Division is guaranteed for the specific academic year indicated in #1 below. Students selected for early admission will be required to maintain a 3.0 GPA in Lower Division and will agree to begin Upper Division courses in the specified academic year. If the awarded GEA does not enroll in the Upper Division during the specified semester, he/she will forfeit the GEA status and must reapply with the general applicant pool to compete for a space in Upper Division.

If awarded a GEA spot, the student MUST apply for Upper Division and complete the background check for the semester they plan to start upper division. They will NOT need to complete the essay again. Please include address where you would like your award letter to be sent below. Letters are mailed in June.
