

## Regular 60-Hour Online Program Curriculum Plans

Welcome to Kent School MSSW Online!

If you are prospective student, please peruse carefully through the curriculum plans and their deadlines below to see what plan works best for you and your lifestyle and so you know when all of your documentation is due. After you have been accepted into the Master of Science in Social Work program, you will enroll for the classes based on which curriculum plan you decide to pursue.

If you are a current student, keep this curriculum plan close to you so you stay on track to graduate on time. Information on the exact process for enrolling in a course can be found on the last page.

Below are the curriculum plans and the due dates for each plan. Please look through it carefully to make the most informed decision on which plan is the best fit for you. There are four plans:

Plan A: 2 Year Full-Time Plan, Graduate in May

Plan B: 2 Year Full-Time Plan, Graduate in August

Plan C: 3 Year Full-Time Plan, Graduate in May

Plan D: 3 Year Mixed Full- and Part-Time Plan, Graduate in May

### Information Regarding Registering for Classes:

- When registering for classes each semester, students should refer to their curriculum plan.
  - The curriculum plans are used to ensure that students proceed through the MSSW program as quickly and successfully as possible.
- **Students are required to follow their chosen curriculum plan every semester when registering for courses.**
  - Please note: All students initial an agreement when admitted that they will follow their chosen curriculum plan while at the Kent School.

- Adding/Dropping classes not indicated on the curriculum plan may delay the students' graduation date and/or affect their financial aid award!

2. Term: semester & year to be viewed
3. Subject: Social Work
4. Press Search Button
5. **WRITE DOWN THE 4-5 DIGIT CLASS NUMBER**
  - The online courses have a section number of 50-59
6. Continue for all classes
