



Internship Opportunity

Kentucky Home Birth Coalition is a grassroots organization actively working to pass legislation to expand birth options in Kentucky. Interns will have the opportunity to participate in grassroots organizing and experience many aspects of the Kentucky legislative process. Internship responsibilities can be tailored to fit the goals, talents, and interests of the intern and may include:

- Creation, editing, and/or graphic design of educational materials for varied audiences;
- Traditional media promotion (press releases, etc);
- Social media contribution;
- Assistance in event planning and promotion, which may include lobby days in Frankfort, regional outreach meetings, and/or fundraisers;
- Fundraising and donor management assistance
- Public health or legal research, synthesis, and writing;
- Legislative advocacy, including opportunities to attend meetings with legislators and policy makers;
- Grant writing;
- Other opportunities may be identified by the intern or the organization!

Assignments can be completed remotely as the intern is available, within a specified time frame. Many assignments will require access to a computer and the internet. Candidate should have excellent written and verbal communication skills. Proficiency in Google Docs/Sheets/Drive is a plus.
