I. Convene Meeting

Having determined a quorum present, Chair Pro Tempore Jurich called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Mr. Jurich noted that Chair Ramsey was ill and unable to attend the meeting. Mr. Jurich welcomed new board members Professors William Cheadle, Robert Staat, and Mary Ann Stenger and Messrs. Rudy Spencer and Trevor Joelson.

II. Consent Agenda

Mr. Jurich read the roll of consent agenda items. Hearing no objection, Prof. Kemelgor made a motion, which Mr. Houston seconded, to approve the consent agenda.

Mr. Jurich congratulated the officers and asked Vice Chair Staat to proceed in chairing the meeting.

IV. Report of the Athletic Director

Mr. Jurich recognized Kevin Miller and his staff for their hard work with the budget.

Mr. Jurich provided updates on the following sports

- Football: a disappointing year with a lot of work to be done. However, he noted there is a lot of energy surrounding the program and great focus on recruiting.
- Field Hockey: team tied for the Big East championship and went to NCAA tournament. The field hockey complex hosted its third Final Four. Mr. Jurich commended Julie Hermann for her diligent work in securing these championship games.
- Men's Soccer: team went to the NCAA tournament. Plagued by injuries, Coach Lolla has done an incredible job this season.
- Women's Soccer: Coach Ferguson did a great job with this team.
- Volleyball: the team won the Big East championship and went to NCAA tournament.
- Women's Cross Country: Tarah McKay, three time Big East and All-Region performer, participated in the NCAA championship. This was her second time to compete in the NCAA championship.

- Men's and Women's Basketball: both teams ranked in the top 10 at this time. Ms. Hermann has done a phenomenal job of marketing the women's program. Paid attendance was close to 17,000, which is a Big East record.
- Golf: the season is off to a great start.
- Men's and Women's Track: Both teams strong competitors.
- Coaches Mann, Bustin and Albiero participated in the 2008 Olympics in Beijing.
- Baseball: Sporting News has named Chris Dominguez as the Preseason National Player of the Year

Big East News: Mr. Jurich reported the Big East is entering into a new negotiation period with ESPN. He also served on the selection committee for the Big East search for a new commissioner. Mr. John Marinatto will replace in Summer 2010 Michael Tranghese as Big East Commissioner. Mr. Marinatto has done an excellent job serving as Senior Associate Commissioner of the Big East.

Mr. Jurich acknowledged Vice President Curtin's work in securing bonding for the expansion. The basketball arena will be a dynamic addition to the community. Mr. Jurich called upon Gary Friedman for a facilities update. Mr. Friedman reported a lot of interest in football loge sales. The staff is doing a great job marketing the seats. The middle section is just about sold out. Fundraising is going well for the stadium expansion. Mr. Friedman credited the staff for a job well done.

He reported plans for the basketball arena are moving along well, too. The arena transition committee, which includes broad based representation, has provided advice and counsel for a fair and equitable plan for moving from Freedom Hall to the new arena in 2010. Current ticket holders will be able to obtain the same number of tickets in the new arena. Mr. Friedman said they were identifying the non-season ticket holder fan base. In January, 2009, a website will be accessible for fans to obtain information about arena seating. In response to Mr. Spencer's inquiry about student input, Mr. Friedman said the transition committee did not address student seating, letter winners, and faculty/staff seating. The transition committee's focus dealt with general public seating. Student input will be obtained through meetings with student groups. Mr. Jurich commended Mr. Friedman and his staff on their excellent efforts to keep the projects moving forward.

Chair Pro Tempore Staat commended Mr. Jurich and his staff on their work with the budget and the remarkable progress made with the facilities.

IV. Report of the Chair
