Having determined a quorum present, Chair Frazier called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

Chair Frazier read the roll of consent agenda items. Hearing no objection, Ms. Scoppechio made a motion, which Ms. Abrams seconded, to approve the consent agenda. The motion passed.

III. Approval of Endowment Match Program Annual Report

President Ramsey reported that every year the Council on Postsecondary Education requires state universities to provide detailed annual reports describing the University's use of state and matching funds during the fiscal year. The report includes such details as the endowed chairs and professorships by name and incumbent, the specific support services attached to the chairs and professorships, and the benefits of the program to the Commonwealth of Kentucky in terms of jobs, revenue growth, creation of wealth, and improved quality of life. The University has identified institutional outcomes, such as increases in extramural funding directly attributable to the program, changes in the quality of students and measurable outcomes such as retention, graduation, pursuit of

advanced study, and employment as well as the creation and profitable use of intellectual property. Mr. Stone made a motion, which Ms. Snowden seconded, to approve the

President's recommendation that the Board of Trustees approve the Endowment Matching Program Annual Report as requested by the Council on Postsecondary Education.

The motion passed.

IV. Action Item: Approval of the Diabetes and Obesity Center

At President Ramsey's request, Dr. Cook explained the Diabetes and Obesity Center will be an organizational unit within the Institute for Molecular Cardiology and will be funded through a National Center for Research Resources (NCRR) grant. The Center will strengthen the institution's biomedical research infrastructure through the establishment of a thematic multi-disciplinary center and will enhance the ability of investigators to compete for National Institutes of Health (NIH) research grants or other external peer-reviewed support. Established investigators will serve as mentors and form the base from which the junior investigators can grow and establish themselves as independent researchers in the areas of diabetes and obesity. Dr. Cook introduced Dr. Aruni Bhatnagar, the Center's director.

Dr. Bhatnagar recognized the Center's particular relevance to Kentucky, citing recent data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention that 63% of Kentuckians are overweight or obese, 35% of Kentucky high school students are overweight or obese and 35% of low-income children between two and five years of age in Kentucky are overweight or at risk of becoming overweight. An estimated 12% of the population in Kentucky is diabetic, and the incidence of diabetes in Kentucky is one of the highest in the country. The number of diabetics in Kentucky doubled from 1990 to 2002. The Center has significant local relevance and will help to meet the mission of UofL becoming a premiere metropolitan research university responsive to the needs of the community.

The Center represents a collaborative effort among a number of departments within the medical school and other units under the umbrella of the Health Sciences Center. The Center will be located organizationally within the Institute for Molecular Cardiology, reporting to the chair of that Institute and the Executive Vice President for Health Affairs. It will be an integral part of the Institute of Molecular Cardiology.

Dr. Bhatnagar fielded questions from board members. Mr. Stone made a motion, which Ms. Snowden seconded, to approve the

President's recommendation that the Board of Trustees approve the creation of the Diabetes and Obesity Center.

The motion passed.

V. Information Update from the Dean, School of Medicine

President Ramsey asked Dean Halperin for an update on the School of Medicine. Dean Halperin summarized the critical programs and projects completed or underway during his 2 1/3 years serving as dean. He noted the School of Medicine's budget was just under \$1 billion, divided as follows: school \$400 million, hospital: \$412 million, and practice plans \$100 million. There are 5,590 faculty and staff positions, with 660 medical students, and 600 interns and residents. Of those 5,590 faculty and staff, 36 report directly to the dean. Dean Halperin discussed current initiatives undertaken by the School of Medicine:

(During the Dean’s presentation, the Board lost the video conference feed to Chair Frazier. Vice Chair Snowden presided over the remainder of the meeting.)

Vice Chair Snowden thanked Dean Halperin for an excellent update.

VI. Report of the President

President Ramsey reported Governor Beshear’s decision to enter into a memorandum of agreement with the University of Louisville to operate Kentucky’s Center for Renewable Energy Research and

Environmental Stewardship was met with great excitement. Dr. Ramsey said the Kentucky General Assembly created the center in 2006 to provide leadership, research, support and policy development in renewable energy. A governor-appointed board will set priorities for renewable energy research. Dr. Ramsey invited Dean Wilhelm to provide more information about the center.

Dean Wilhelm thanked President Ramsey and the leadership of the University as well as Henry and Rebecca Conn for their efforts in creating this exceptional opportunity for the university and the community. He explained that UofL has expertise to address the use of wind, solar, geothermal, and biomass resources; energy storage; and the logistics and distribution challenges for new energy sources. The center's mission will include promoting partnerships among the state's colleges and universities, private industry and nonprofit organizations to actively pursue federal research and development resources that are dedicated to renewable energy. President Ramsey read a resolution of appreciation to Henry and Rebecca Conn. Ms. Jackson made a motion, which Ms. Scoppechio seconded, to approve the

Henry and Rebecca Conn

WHEREAS, Henry "Hank" Conn received his Bachelor's and Master's Degree in Mechanical Engineering from the Speed School of Engineering and his Master's in Business Administration from UofL's College of Business and with our deep gratitude Rebecca "Becky" Conn became an "adopted alum" of the University of Louisville on January 21, 2005; and

WHEREAS, Hank's illustrious career at the Louisville Ford Heavy Truck Assembly Plant along with his academic training at the University of Louisville have shaped the foundation for his outstanding success in consulting; and

WHEREAS, Hank's expertise in leadership as reported through his books, Workplace 2000, the Revolution Reshaping American Business; Maximum Performance Management: How to Manage and Compensate People to Meet World Competition; and Creating the Environment for Total Quality Management has recognized him as a scholar; and

WHEREAS, the breadth of Hank's professional accomplishments in business and executive development have engendered a sincere interest in both Becky and Hank for supporting the future of engineering at their alma mater through establishing a new research direction in renewable energy; and

WHEREAS, the wonderfully generous gift of Hank and Becky Conn has provided \$20 million to launch the Conn Center for Renewable Energy Research and Environmental Stewardship at UofL's Speed School of Engineering, which established this center as the Commonwealth's initiative in renewable energy research; and

WHEREAS, Kentucky Governor Steve Beshear and UofL President James Ramsey have praised the Conns' unselfish dedication in support of pioneering faculty research at Speed School in wind, solar, geothermal and biomass resources; energy storage; and the logistics and distribution challenges for new energy sources; and

WHEREAS, Henry "Hank" and Rebecca "Becky" Conn are gifted leaders who respect their heritage and understand the future of Kentucky and America depends on inspired business leaders who will follow their commitment to advancing research in the energy frontier to make our country resource sufficient; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the University of Louisville hereby expresses its sincere admiration to Henry "Hank" and Rebecca "Becky" Conn for their expertise as business and community leaders, executive consultants, scholarly authors, and University of Louisville alumni;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the University of Louisville also expresses its deep appreciation to Henry and Rebecca Conn for their most generous pledge of more than \$20 million to the Speed School of Engineering, the largest recorded individual gift to a public university in Kentucky, which will establish UofL as an international premier center in the field of renewable energy; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution, appropriately signed and framed, be presented to the Conns on an occasion where their family and many friends and colleagues may observe the University's great respect for our distinguished alumni.

The motion passed.

With a Powerpoint presentation, President Ramsey reviewed Kentucky employment data. He shared information about the state budget deficit and anticipated budget cuts. The President expressed optimism for the University's continued movement toward goals outlined in the 2020 Plan. Budget cuts make this more challenging; the President restated, however, the strong commitment of the University's leadership team to achieve the established goals.

Dr. Ramsey provided an update on 2008-09 goals. There are 35 goals with 19 of those shared goals. The goals are set for each member of the leadership team. Dr. Ramsey asked Provost Willihnganz to discuss recruitment of vacant dean positions. Dr. Willihnganz reported that Dr. Blake Haselton and Dr. Bill Pierce currently serve as interim deans. They are doing a superb job and she would like for them to continue in this capacity for one more academic year.

Dr. Ramsey called up Dr. Cook to provide an update. Dr. Cook updated the board on goals on community partnership, University Hospital (working with hospital CEO and board chair), and enhance the educational program and reputation of the University by investing in technologies, space, accreditation and new programs that create quality in academic programs, improve responsiveness to community and national needs, and advance the educational value of the University.

Dr. Ramsey called upon Dr. Martinez for an update. Dr. Martinez reported that the University will receive notification in mid March regarding the Clinical Translational Research Science awards.

The President acknowledged the outstanding service Ms. Snowden has given to autism fundraising. Ms. Snowden reported that 1 in 150 children, and 1 in 94 boys, develop autism. The condition makes teaching a difficult situation. The Autism Center needs a director and hopefully an endowed chair. UofL basketball great Darrell Griffith has served as spokesperson for a raffle program to benefit autism -Go Cards! Big East Basketball Tournament Raffle prize including four tournament tickets, four seats on UofL's charter flight to New York, two rooms at the Marriott Marquis on Times Square and \$1,000. Chances are \$20. Proceeds support UofL's new Autism Center and the Families for Effective Autism Treatment (FEAT of Louisville) scholarship fund. This concluded the President's Report.

2009 Alumni Fellows Nominations by School

College of Arts and Sciences – Mitzi Friedlander

Mitzi Friedlander received her BA in English in 1952 and her MA in Theatre Arts in 1971. In fact, she was the first person to receive a MA in Theatre Arts at the University of Louisville. However, her commitment to the University, the Louisville community and to education as a whole has continued through her lifetime.

A well-known figure in Louisville's theatrical world, Ms. Friedlander performed with Actor's Theatre Louisville, the Louisville Ballet, the Kentucky Opera Association, and the Louisville Children's Theatre. She also taught Theatre Arts at the University of Louisville and at Indiana University Southeast.

Despite the many facets of her theatre arts career, Ms. Friedlander is best known for her outstanding work and commitment as a Talking Book narrator at the American Printing House for the Blind (APH) for whom she has been working for over 45 years. The Talking Book program, administered by the National Library Service for the Blind and Physically Handicapped of the Library of Congress, provides recorded literature to visually impaired, and physically disabled Americans.

In 2004, Mitzi Friedlander was honored by the Pleiades Theater Company of Louisville. She was presented with one of seven STAR Awards for significant arts achievement. Ms. Friedlander was honored for being a teacher and performer of theater and musical arts.

As of 2007, Mitzi Friedlander has recorded nearly 1,500 books for the Talking Book program since she began working at APH. She is familiar to millions of people in the listening audience as the voice of such classics as *Gone with the Wind* and *Charlotte's Web*.

College of Business – Charles P. Denny

Charles P. Denny is the Regional President of the newly formed National City/PNC Bank of Kentucky/Indiana and received his BSB in Business in 1975 and his MBA in 1980 from the University of Louisville.

Chuck's many professional achievements include: Chairman, UofL Board of Overseers; Chairman Elect, Greater Louisville Inc.; Louisville Medical Center Development Corp.; Baptist Hospital East Board of Directors; Vice-Chair Downtown Development Corp. Board of Directors; UofL Health Sciences – NUCLEUS Board of Directors; Kentucky Bankers Assoc.; Chair, Metro United Way, 2007 Campaign, and UofL College of Business Board of Advisors.

As an alumnus of the university, Chuck received the College of Business Alumni Service Award in 1982 and served as the College of Business' Alumni Association President 1980-1981.

School of Dentistry – John N. Williams, Jr. D.M.D., M.B.A.

Dr. John Williams received his D.M.D. in 1980 and his MBA in 1987 from the University of Louisville. He is a lifetime member of the University Of Louisville School Of Dentistry's Second Century Society and a recipient of the University of Louisville's Distinguished Alumni Award in 2004.

College of Education & Human Development –Constance M. Unsel

Constance “Connie” Unsel received her B.S. degree in Education in 1970 and her Master in Early Childhood Education from Towson State University and went on to become the founder, owner and director of Unsel's School, a private school with over 200 students in Baltimore, Maryland.

The Unsel's School is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, and the Maryland State Department of Education. The school has been acclaimed as a “School of Excellence” in the United States and is built upon the philosophy that “every child can learn.”

Connie was bestowed the honor of delivering the commencement address at Coppin State University for its first graduating class in May, 2004. Connie's professional affiliations include the Unsel's School Association, Women's Cancer Research, Baltimore Smart Set, the Independent School Association, and the Maryland Childcare Association. She has served and/or is currently serving on the following boards: Board of Directors for the Coppin State University Foundation Board, the Children's Home Advisory Board, Maryland Society for Sight, McDaniel College, Loyola College, St. Joseph's Foundation Board, Kennedy Krieger Institute, and the American Cancer society.

J.B. Speed School of Engineering – Benjamin M. Streepey

Benjamin Streepey is the Vice-President and General Manager of Business Supplies at Lexmark International. He is responsible for worldwide development, manufacturing, marketing and sales and the financial results of the business.

Ben is on the Board of Directors of St. Joseph's Healthcare, UK's Engineering Dean's Advisory Council, Speed School Dean's Industrial Board of Advisors, and the UofL Central Kentucky Alumni Club. He received his B.S. in 1978 and his Masters from the U of L Speed School in 1979.

Kent School of Social Work – Jay Davidson

Jay Davidson has been President and CEO of The Healing Place, in downtown Louisville, since June, 2004. He received his MSSW from the Kent School of Social Work in 1991.

The Healing place is a 436-bed (men, women and children) shelter that provides a sobering-up center, an emergency shelter and a recovery program for homeless men, women and children respectively. The center provides 40,000+ meals and 9,500+ beds per month. Jay is responsible for the overall operation of the organization; including finance and administration, fund development, public relations and

communications, facilities management, program administration of the shelter recovery programs, supervision of the free health care clinic and Board member recruitment and development.

In 2008, Mr. Davidson was awarded the 2008 Purpose Prize for “innovation and extraordinary social contribution in an encore career.” Winners were chosen from more than 1,000 nominees for their creative and effective work tackling problems ranging from poverty to pollution, recidivism to racial reconciliation, health care to homelessness.

Davidson’s work with alcoholics and addicts has literally saved thousands of lives. Men and women that had once given up all hope of recovery have been restored to productive lives, reunited with their families, and contributing in their local communities.

Louis D. Brandeis School of Law – Howard Fineman

Howard Fineman is Newsweek's senior Washington Correspondent and columnist, senior editor and deputy Washington Bureau Chief. He is also the author of "Living Politics," a column that began and continues on MSNBC.com and Newsweek.com and is now featured in the print magazine. An award-winning writer, Fineman is also an NBC News Analyst, contributing reports to the network and its cable affiliates. The author of scores of Newsweek cover stories, Fineman's work has also appeared in The New York Times, The Washington Post and The New Republic. Fineman authored his first book in 2008, *The Thirteen American Arguments: Enduring Debates That Define and Inspire Our Country*.

As the 2008 campaign begins, Fineman has interviewed candidates such as John McCain, Hillary Rodham Clinton, Barack Obama, John Edwards and Rudy Giuliani. Although Fineman now reports on TV exclusively for NBC, he has appeared on most major public affairs shows, including: Nightline, Face the Nation, Larry King Live, Fox News Sunday, Charlie Rose, and The NewsHour with Jim Lehrer. He was a regular panelist on PBS's Washington Week in Review, 1983-1995 and on CNN's Capital Gang Sunday, 1995-1998. He worked with Ted Koppel to produce Nightline special reports on Ross Perot and Pat Robertson.

A native of Pittsburgh, Fineman began his journalism career at The Louisville Courier-Journal, covering the environment, the coal industry and state politics before joining the newspaper's Washington bureau in 1978. He moved to Newsweek in 1980, was named chief political correspondent in 1984, Deputy Washington bureau chief in 1993 and senior editor in 1995.

Fineman holds an A.B., Phi Beta Kappa, from Colgate, an M.S. in journalism from Columbia, and a J.D. from the University of Louisville. His legal education included a year at the Georgetown University Law Center. He received Watson and Pulitzer Traveling Fellowships for study in Europe, Russia and the Middle East. He lives in Washington with his wife and their two children.

School of Medicine – Larry Gibson, M.D.

Dr. Larry Gibson, is on the staff at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN. where he is a Professor of Dermatology in the College of Medicine. Dr. Gibson graduated from the University of Louisville School of Medicine in 1980 and cum laude from Mayo Graduate School of Medicine internal medicine internship program.

Dr. Gibson is board certified in dermatology, dermatopathology and immunodermatology. His interests include cutaneous vasculitis, cutaneous lymphoma and immunobullous diseases. He has lectured on

these topics at various international meetings including those sponsored by the International Society of Dermatology, as well as given numerous professional presentations, both nationally and internationally on topics ranging from cutaneous vasculitis, general dermatology manifestations of HIV to skin manifestations of systemic illness.

He has peer reviewed over 100 articles, published 25 book chapters, and authored numerous articles on various dermatological topics.

Board memberships and positions include: American Board of Dermatology – 1985 to present, National Board of Medical Examiners – 1981 with licensure in Minnesota, Arizona, Florida and Michigan.

School of Music – Patrick L. Harbison

Patrick Harbison received his Bachelor in Music Education from the University of Louisville in 1977 and his Masters in Jazz Studies at Indiana University in 1987. He is currently the Professor of Jazz Studies at Indiana University's Jacobs School of Music.

Mr. Harbison is the co-founder of Jazz from Bloomington (JFB) and served as its president for 4 years and as a member of the Board of Directors for 7 years. JFB is a not-for-profit tax-exempt organization founded in 1999 and presents concerts, educational events, and outreach activities in pursuit of its mission to develop the south central Indiana jazz audience and nurture the creative environment of the region's jazz artists and aficionados.

He is an active jazz clinician and has been a faculty member of Jamey Aebersold's Summer Jazz Workshops since 1976.

School of Nursing – Patricia Howard, PhD, RN, CNAA

Pat Howard graduated from the University of Louisville in 1979 with a bachelor's degree in nursing. Since that time she has distinguished herself in nursing practice, science and education. Psychiatric nursing is her research focus area. Her clinical area is psychiatric-mental health nursing, with an emphasis on informal caregivers and public mental health service delivery systems.

Dr. Howard has been published in numerous journals and publications, including *Archives of Psychiatric Nursing*, *International Psychiatry*, *Issues in Mental Health Nursing*, and *Journal of Psychosocial Nursing* to name a few. She has given regional, national, and international presentations on her findings, including the American Nurses Association Council of Nurse Researchers, the International Society for Psychiatric Mental Health Nursing, the Southern Nursing Research Society, and the National Association of Mental Health Program Directors Institute.

In addition to her published body of work in the field of psychiatric nursing, Dr. Howard has consistently received state and federal grants to fund her research efforts. Susan Harkema, Ph.D.

WHEREAS, Dr. Harkema has served the University of Louisville as Associate Professor, Department of Neurological Surgery, and Rehabilitation Research Director for the Kentucky Spinal Cord Injury Research Center, and Director of Research, Frazier Rehabilitation Institute;

WHEREAS, Dr. Harkema is a leading researcher in the field of neurological rehabilitation. She currently holds the positions of Associate Professor in the Department of Neurological Surgery at the University of Louisville, Rehabilitation Research Director at the Kentucky Spinal Cord Injury Research Center and Director of Research at the Frazier Rehab Institute in Louisville;

WHEREAS, At the Kentucky Spinal Cord Injury Research Center, Dr. Harkema's studies related to Locomotor Training contribute to the knowledge about the fundamental mechanisms that control human locomotion and may provide strategies to be used by physical therapists for the rehabilitation of walking for patients after neurologic injury;

WHEREAS, from 1998 to 2005, while Dr. Harkema was an assistant professor in residence at the Department of Neurology of UCLA, she worked to develop a unique human model to explore the neural mechanisms that are responsible for sensory processing at the level of the spinal cord. Her involvement in perceiving the level of neuromuscular plasticity after neurologic injury and the neural mechanisms responsible for locomotion primarily focused on those individuals with spinal cord injury.

WHEREAS, Dr. Harkema is the Director of the NeuroRecovery Network (NRN)- a revolutionary new program launched by the Christopher and Dana Reeve Foundation (CDRF). The NRN is a cooperative network of cutting-edge rehabilitation centers designed to provide and develop therapies to promote functional recovery and improve the overall health of people living with paralysis. Funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention through an agreement with the CDRF, the NRN translates the latest scientific advances into effective, activity-based rehabilitation treatments such as Locomotor Training.

WHEREAS, Dr. Harkema's active involvement with a program on behalf of the National Institutes of Health entitled "Plasticity of Human Spinal Neural Networks after Injury," will help to understand neuromuscular plasticity in response to spinal cord injury;

WHEREAS, Dr. Harkema has published numerous scholarly articles on her research and has received several honors and awards throughout her career.

WHEREAS, In 2005, Dr. Harkema became the Owsley B. Frazier Rehabilitation Chair in Neurological Surgery at the University of Louisville. Most recently, the National Spinal Cord Injury Association nominated Dr. Harkema into the SCI Hall of Fame for Achievement in Research in Quality of Life; and
