This leadership development program is targeted to **next generation leaders, high-performers and aspiring executives** working within a family-owned business.

The program curriculum concentrates on the development of key competencies including:

- Management and Leadership Principles
- Coaching and Motivational Impact
- Formal and Interactive Communication
- Organizational and Productivity Enhancement
- Critical Thinking Empowerment

Program participants will earn a **Management Development Certificate** from the University of Louisville upon completion and satisfaction of all program requirements.

The program begins with an opening kickoff session for program participants and their organization leaders in November 2017 to define success and set expectations. A **series of eight (8) workshops** will be delivered to the program participants on an approximate four-week interval from December 2017 through July 2018. A closing session will bring program participants and organizational leaders back together as we round out the program in July 2018.

Active participation and attendance at all program sessions is required. **Tests and on-the-job project assignments** will be integrated into the learning experience throughout the program. Lunch and all program materials will be provided. All program sessions will be held on the University of Louisville's Shelby Campus, unless otherwise indicated.

A minimum of 20 participants will be required to launch the program. Maximum enrollment for the cohort will be 30. **The discounted program fee for Family Business Center members is \$2,500.** The non-member fee is \$3,000.

- Becoming an Extraordinary Problem Solver
