**Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of November 8, 2006 were approved.

**Course Proposals Considered**

1. **MGMT 310 – Minorities, Managers, and the Workplace APPROVED**  
Retroactive CD2 credit will also apply to students taking the course this Spring 2007 semester. This is an exception to the UofL general education policy that states general education credit will not be granted retroactively.
  
2. **COM 325 – Communicating Hip Hop Culture APPROVED**  
The committee agreed that the outcomes section of the proposal should be reworked. Approved on the condition that Chair B. Williams will receive and review a revision of the outcomes section and make a final determination.
  
3. **JA 523 – NOT APPROVED**  
This is an existing course that is now seeking CD1 designation. The general education program does not allow 500-level courses. This policy is in place because general education courses should be available to any and all undergraduate students.
