Type of position: volunteer for first semester, 491 or 492 credit for further semesters

Time commitment: 2 semester minimum commitment required; research assistants must complete 4-7 hours per week as volunteers in their first semester and 9-10 hours per week for 401 credit in their second semester, must be available for lab meetings on Fridays (time to be determined)

Semesters position is available: Every fall and spring semester, occasionally summer

Location of work: Davidson 302, local schools, and occasionally other sites in the community

Qualifications: minimum 3.0 GPA in Psychology courses, experience working with children preferred

Brief description of project: The KID lab researches how children ages 3-12 think about information.

Specific tasks: assist in creating stimuli, testing children in the lab and at schools, entering data, and recruiting families.
